

LIGHT VEHICLE DRIVER

Nature of work

The principal and customary work of the employee in this employment class consists in driving an automobile, a small truck, a minibus, a van or any similar vehicle with a capacity of less than three thousand (3,000) kg (net vehicle weight) to transport people, merchandise, tools, equipment and materials; he loads and unloads his vehicle in accordance with the existing safety standards.

Required qualifications

Pertinent skills

To be able to use forms (delivery, receiving or shipping).

To have basic knowledge of light vehicle mechanics and of the various preventive maintenance methods.

Other requirements

To have a driver's licence in the appropriate category.

Some characteristic duties

The employee in this employment class drives vehicles such as an automobile, a small truck, a minibus, etc.

He must keep his vehicle clean and in good driving condition (washing, cleaning, refuelling). He must make a daily inspection or, as frequently as instructed, of the state of his vehicle and report any defect noticed.

He must keep a route record and, if necessary, prepare brief reports concerning certain activities related to the performance of his duties.

He may be called upon to operate an ice resurfacer.

If need be, he performs any other related tasks.
