

CARPENTER

Nature of work

The principal and customary work of the employee in this employment class consists in performing alteration, repair, frame, finishing and other carpentry work done with wood, metal or other materials.

Required qualifications

To have the legal qualifications prescribed by regulation for this employment class;
or
to have a diploma of vocational studies in an appropriate specialty and one (1) year of pertinent experience.

Some characteristic duties

The employee in this employment class performs general frame and finishing tasks and any other work such as:

- setting up and dismantling concrete casings;
- the construction, setting up and dismantling of scaffolding;
- the installation of doors, door frames, locks, lock barrels, insulation, window panes, acoustic tiles on stationary or hanging ceilings (as well as the preliminary work), the laying and repairing of floors, window installation;
- the installation and the removal of dividers made of metal, wood or other materials;
- the making and repairing of furniture, cupboards, shelves and other woodwork which are not part of cabinet making.

In the performance of his duties, he may be called upon to execute assembling, gluing, sanding and adjustment tasks.

The carpenter may be called upon to co-ordinate the work of less experienced or non-specialized workmen.

If need be, he performs any other related tasks.
