

## STATIONARY ENGINEER

### Nature of work

The principal and customary work of the employee in this employment class consists, depending on his level of responsibility, in carrying out tasks related to the operation either of heating apparatus and steam engines or of refrigeration apparatus or both.

### Required qualifications

To have the legal qualifications prescribed by regulation for this employment class.

### Some characteristic duties

#### The chief stationary engineer

The employee in this employment class manages the operation of one or more stationary plants consisting either of heating apparatus and steam engines or of refrigeration apparatus or both.

In the carrying out of his duties, he may also perform the task of team leader. As such, he manages a team of stationary engineers and support personnel, performs the duties of the members of his team, carries out, if need be, the most difficult tasks, distributes the work, initiates new workers, collaborates in their training and writes work reports.

If need be, he performs any other related tasks.

#### The stationary engineer

The employee in this employment class is responsible for overseeing the operation and ensuring the maintenance and inspection of one or more stationary plants consisting either of heating apparatus and steam engines or of refrigeration apparatus or both.

If need be, he performs any other related tasks.

#### The stationary engineer helper

The employee in this employment class performs any task to help the stationary engineer; he becomes familiar with the operation of one or more stationary plants consisting either of heating apparatus and steam engines or of refrigeration apparatus or both and requiring the presence of a stationary engineer. He carries out the maintenance of the equipment and the premises, and he takes the readings of monitors.

If need be, he performs any other related tasks.
