

MEASUREMENT AND EVALUATION ADVISOR

Nature of the work

The measurement and evaluation advisor is a professional whose occupation includes, in particular, leading activities for and providing assistance to the teachers and other personnel concerned in the evaluation of the students' performance.

His mandate includes, among others, establishing measurement and evaluation policies, developing and utilizing suitable instruments of measurement, and administrating files and academic transcripts.

Required qualifications

A bachelor's degree with a specialization appropriate to the employment such as docimology.

Some characteristic functions

The measurement and evaluation advisor implements the docimology and the taxonomy of the educational objectives.

He prepares the statistics needed for the purpose of information, studies and research.

He deals with the classification and safekeeping of academic results and is responsible for the issuing of attestations of studies.
